Lesson 2: Milk Quality & Safety: Keeping Milk Fresh

Lesson Introduction

How does milk get from moo to you? In this lesson, students will learn how the milk you drink gets from the cow on a dairy farm to you at home and school. The lesson will also highlight the career of being a milk truck driver.

Lesson Objectives

• Students will list the steps of milk from the cow to them.

• Students will identify dairy foods.

• Students will list the skills and responsibilities of being a milk truck driver.

Procedure

Introduction (5 minutes)

- Introduction
- Activating Strategy: Let's look at how milk gets from Moo to You by watching the video, <u>The Journey of Milk</u>. Use Lesson 2 PowerPoint slides 1-3.

- Go over the essential vocabulary terms and their meanings for this lesson.
- Use the Lesson 2 PowerPoint, slides 4-10 to show the meaning in pictures.

From Moo to You: The Journey of Milk (10 minutes)

- o Introduction, slide 11
- Go over the six important parts to the milk journey using PowerPoint slides 12-17.
- Closure: We learned more about the six steps for milk's journey from the cow to you. Share with us one step you remember from our exploration, slide 18.

Career Spotlight: Milk Truck Driver (6 minutes)

- o Introduction, slide 19
- Facilitate the Career Spotlight on Milk Truck Driver using the <u>Milk Truck Drivers</u> from Valley Grove Dairy video and discussion of responsibilities of milk truck drivers. Share the <u>Milk Truck Driver Career Spotlight worksheet</u> with the students. Use slides 20-22 to guide the conversation.
- Closure: A milk truck driver plays an important part in milk's journey from moo to you. Use slide 23.
 - Tell us one responsibility of a milk truck driver.
 - Are you interested in being a milk truck driver when you grow up?

Summative Activity (15-30 minutes, depending on the activities)

- Introduction
- Pass out any of the activities: <u>Journey of Milk Maze</u>, <u>From Moo to You Sequencing Activity</u>, <u>From Moo to You Storyboard Activity</u>, and/or grade specific writing prompts.
- $\circ\,$ Allow students class time to complete the selected activities.
- Walk around, offering help and answering questions as needed.
- Lesson Closure: Today you learned about the journey of milk from moo to you.
 The last step in the process is you. Tell us one thing you need to do to keep milk safe.

Career Spotlight: Milk Truck Driver

Description

The milk truck driver is an essential member of the dairy farmer's team. They ensure the milk is safely transported from the farm to the processing plant.

Farmers and consumers depend on a milk truck driver. They play a key roll in getting the farm fresh milk to your refrigerator in less than 72 hours.

Common Responsibilities

- Test the milk to make sure it is safe
- Pump the milk from the bulk tank to the milk truck
- Drive the milk from the farm to the milk processing plant safely













Dairy Cows Getting Milked






Let's explore six important steps to the journey of milk from cow to you.




STEP 1: THE FARMER



Farmers make sure the barn is clean and safe.




Farmers feed and water cows all day.




Farmers take care of cows when they are sick.




STEP 2: THE COWS



Cows eat about 100 pounds of feed and drink a bathtub full of water.




Cows like to be milked.




Cows are milked two or three times every day.



STEP 3: THE MILK TANK



Milk goes from the cow to the milk tank in hoses and pipes.



Milk is never touched by human hands.



Milk is cooled and put in the milk tank.




STEP 4: THE MILK TRUCK



Milk is tested before it goes on the milk truck.




Milk trucks take the milk from the farm to the milk processing plant.



The milk stays cold in the milk truck.



STEP 5: THE MILK PROCESSING PLANT



Milk is tested many times at the plant.



Milk is pasteurized to kill any germs.



Milk is made into different types of milk and other dairy foods.




STEP 6: THE STORE AND YOU



Milk is shipped cold to stores.



It takes less than two days for the milk to travel from farm to you.




You should keep your milk and dairy foods cold, covered, and clean.

WHO IS THE MILK TRUCK DRIVER

The milk truck driver is the person who takes milk from the farm to the milk processing plant.





MILK TRUCK DRIVER RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Test the milk to make sure it is safe.
- 2. Pump the milk from the milk tank to the milk truck.
- 3. Drive the milk from the farm to the milk processing plant.
