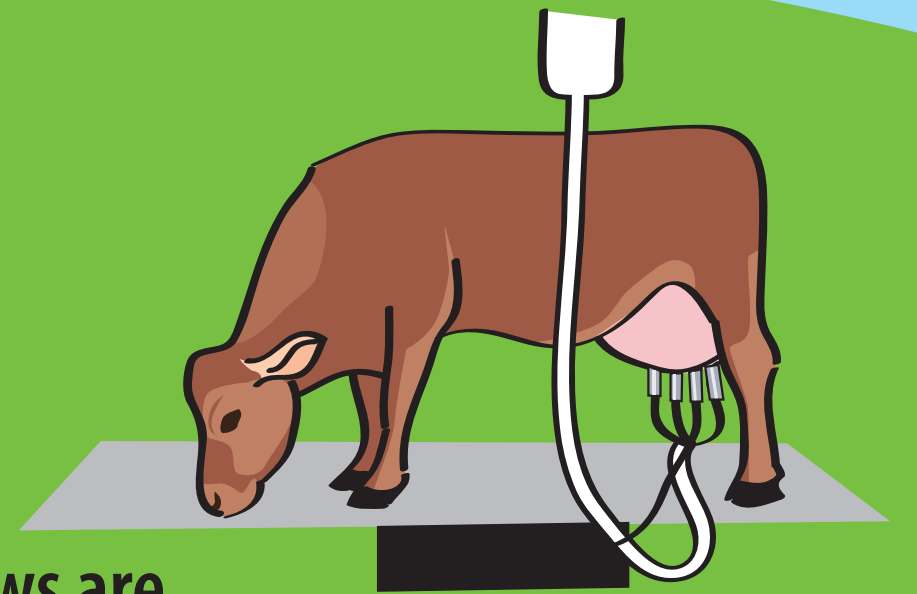


MILK'S JOURNEY FROM THE FARM TO THE FRIDGE

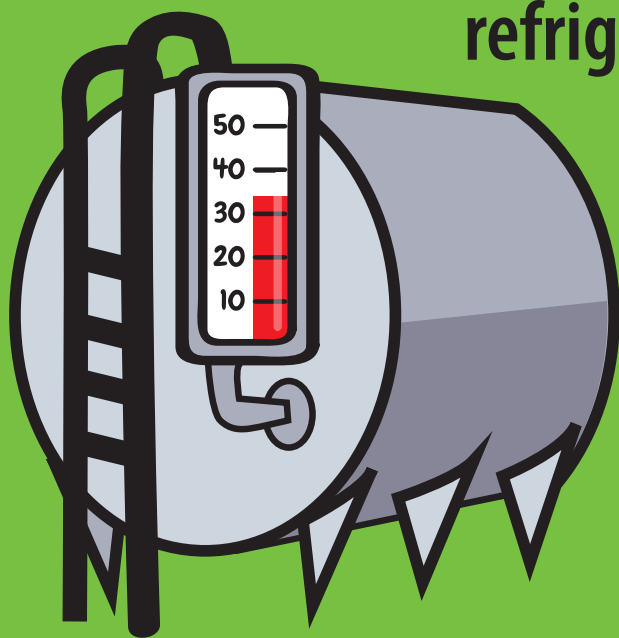
Your adopted calf will begin producing milk at about 2 years old, after she has a baby.



Dairy cows are milked 2 to 3 times a day and can give up to 15 gallons of milk a day.



The milk that cows produce is quickly cooled down to 38 degrees in a refrigerated milk tank.



A milk truck arrives at the farm every other day to pick up the milk and take it to a processing plant.



Once at the processing plant, the milk can be bottled into milk or made into dairy products like yogurt, ice cream and cheese.
